

School of Nursing hosts PRONTO training

The University of Nairobi PRIME-K Linked MNCH grant on “Strengthening Maternal, Newborn and Child Health Research Training in Kenya” organised a PRONTO training workshop for University of Nairobi and Kenya Medical Training College Faculty and for senior midwives from 7-9 March 2016 at Skills lab, School of Nursing Sciences at the College of Health Sciences, UoN.

PRONTO is an adaptable obstetric and neonatal emergency simulation team training programme that uses a high-fidelity and low-technology birth simulation within the national guidelines. The training has its origin in the US and has been implemented in Latin America, India, Kenya and a few other African Countries.

A total of 17 University of Nairobi and Kenya Medical Training College Faculty and for senior midwives were trained on introduction to Simulation and Team training with a view of integrating obstetric and neonatal emergency simulation into the teaching.
